Instructions for the students-

- (a) The students' 'Internship Programme' is mandatory under UGC and Calcutta University Regulation.
- (b) The internship may be for a period of **15 days to 30 days with at least 60 hours duration.** As per UGC and CU Regulation internship may be undertaken either at the end of 2nd /4th /6th Semester with or without exit from the B. Com Course.
- (c) Submission of Project Note Book (50 marks) and attending the Viva–Voce (25 marks) are mandatory. Any candidate failing to comply with either of the component shall be declared as unsuccessful in Internship.
- (d) Each student should fill up the application for internship through Google Form the link of which is given at the end of this Notice.
- (e) Each student has to select <u>only one institution</u>. Institution once selected by the students cannot be changed afterwards.
- (f) On finalisation of the institution and the course structure, the students should take admission to their respective selected institution through the institution's Admission Desk to be set up in the College.
- (g) Finally, after admission, the class timing, venue will be informed by the concerned institute where the students have taken admission.
- (h) The mode of payment of fees, the date of taking admission all will be notified time to time in the College website and the students are strictly instructed to follow the website of the college.
 - (i) After successful completion of the course, the certificate issued by the institute along with the project report will be submitted by the students before the external experts as sent by the University on the day and date as fixed by the college for evaluation of the projects. Without such evaluation the students will be declared absent and his/her degree will remain incomplete.

programme.

University will come to the college on the day and date as fixed by the college for

evaluation of the projects.
