

Action Taken Report -2016-17

The feedback received from different stakeholders, especially from students, has been reviewed thoroughly. On that basis the following actions have been taken keeping in mind the interest of the stakeholders-

1. Repairing, renovation and Painting of the college building (main campus) was satisfactorily completed and the college building got a new life.
2. 'Wi-Fi' (Net) and LAN facility has been provided in college library, staffroom and at Principal's chamber.
3. KOHA' Programme has been installed and approximately 1,000 books have been entered and ready for web upload.
4. E-Gate has been installed in front of the Reading Room of college library of main campus.
5. Initiatives have been taken to open a general section in the extended campus from coming academic year (2017-18). Calcutta University Inspection Team visited Extended Campus for the same.
6. W.B. Govt. sanctioned Rs. 3,00,000/- (three lakh) for virtual classroom [Govt. Order No. 840- EDN (CS) /1G-08/16. Dt. 14.09.16]. Works have been started and is expected to be completed by the next academic year.
7. A committee was formed to look into the matter of construction of boundary wall at Extended campus.
8. For reconstruction and renovation of Principal's own chamber and remodeling of Students' Union canteen a budget was prepared and G.B. approved and sanctioned a sum of Rs. 9 lakhs for reconstruction and renovation and another Rs 10 lakh for installation of A.C machine. Canteen of the college and Union Room of the Students' Union was renovated.
10. After placing requisition to College Service Commission for filling up the vacancies of Teaching post and the post of Librarian (vacant from 30/01/1989) we got four teaching posts filled during the academic year-
 - i) Dr. Mahasweta Bhattacharya joined in Commerce Dept. on 17.12.2016
 - ii) Mrs.. Aatreyee Ghosh joined on 06.05.2017 in the Dept. of English.
 - iii) Mr.Basanta Barman also joined in the Dept. of English on 15.05.2017
 - iv) Mr.Rama Mallik joined the Department of Mathematics on 16/05/2017
11. We placed requisition to the C.S.C for creation of post of Librarian but no librarian post was sanctioned.
12. For beautification of college premises at Extended campus, during the 'forest- week' the students and Teachers planted a number of tree saplings (mainly Eucalyptus) near the boundary wall.
13. The Placement call of the college in consultation and assistance with Principal organized placement drives (campus interview) and 34 (thirty four) students were recruited by TCS.
14. A-2-day National Level Seminar on "Contemporary Issues in Accounting and Finance." was held in the college on 2-3, December, 2016. An edited volume was also published. Mr. Debendra Shaw, was the chief editor of the same.
15. Dr. Kamal Kumar, Asst. Prof., Dept. of Hindi, participated in a Faculty Development Programme from 09-01-2017 to 20-01-2017.
16. Mr. Debendra Shaw, Asst. Prof. in Commerce attended a Refresher Course in Ranchi University from 16/06/2017 to 06/07/2017.
17. In sports the achievement of the college was as follows-
 - The college became champion in CAB CRICKET TOURNAMENT
 - The college became champion in RED BULL CRICKET TOURNAMENT
 - The college became champion in SUPER CUP T-20 TOURNAMENT

- Our student Dharmendra Prasad obtained 2ND Place in High Jump in INTER COLLEGE SPORTS
