

# **Alumni Feedback Analysis**

Despite the college's short existence of only twenty years, its graduates may be found in a wide range of professions, including social, political, entertainment, and business. The alumni feedback led to the conclusion that follows. There were 60 alumni that provided feedback in all. Out of which 45 were B.Com. honours students and 15 were B.Com. general students. The majority of them (20) enrolled in 2018, while 15 and 13 respondents enrolled in 2017 and 2016, respectively 20 of the responders graduated in the year 2021, 16 of them graduated in 2020 and 12 of them in the year 2019Every respondent endorsed attending Umeschandra College for academic pursuits. 40 respondents have indicated that they currently possess a B.Com degree; 7 have an M.Com, 12 have an MBA, and one holds an M.Phil. Of the respondents, 33 work in private enterprise, while 15 are self - employed.Most of the alumni (67%) rated quality of activities organized for overall development of students as excellent, 20% alumni rated it as very good, 10% as good. The student teacher relationship was rated as excellent by 78%, very good by 13% and good by 9% alumni. The alumni appreciated the laboratories, 89% alumni felt it as excellent, 7% very good and 4% as good. The quality of teaching learning was rated as excellent by 70% alumni, 25% very good. 70% alumni felt the campus as excellent and 25% very good.78% alumni gave excellent, 10% very good, 5%good rating for the library. They appreciate the institution for offering high-quality instruction in such a remote area. They value the college staff's commitment, friendliness, and spirit of cooperation. They show their indebtedness towards college for the efforts and hard work of the faculty. They admit that the college played crucial role in shaping their professional, ethical and personal life. They admit that their association with the college not only enabled them to acquire a degree but also it helped them to become human beings and the college also helped to inculcate human values among them and enriched every sphere of their life. They proudly acknowledge that the college helped them develop their communication skills, leadership abilities, social commitment, and responsibilities, and that it was only because of the college that they became social and formed lifelong relationships. Confidence was developed through college programmes, and teachers encouraged students to participate in these programmes. 






























#### PARENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS



The Overall average of the parent's feedback was excellent (about 88%) on Ambience of the college with respect to the facilities given to your wards,7% parents felt it was very good and about 5% felt as good and few reported it as poor. Learning experience of your son/ daughter in the college was rated excellent by (78%), (13%) very good, 9% good, by parents. Academic skills and knowledge of the college facultwas also highly commended by most of the parentsand it was rated (78%) excellent, 20% very good, 2% good. 




















### TEACHER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS


Most of the teachers (58%) rated the allocation of the classes in proportionate to the time stipulated in the syllabusas excellent, 35% as very good, 2% as good. 68% teachers felt timing of the library as well as the procedure for issue/return of books as excellent, 25% very good, 7% as good. The Librarywas rated as excellent by 65% teachers, 33% very good,2% as good. 75% teachers felt the facility provided in collegeas excellent, 13% very good, 12% good. Effectiveness of internal evaluation system were received ratings as excellent by 56%,very good 35%,good 7%,average 1%; 58% teachers gave excellent, 32% very good, 10%good forCollege website.Opportunities offered by the college are assessed as exceptional by 48% of respondents, very good by 23%, good by 20%, and ordinary by 5%. 40% of respondents agree, 35% strongly agree, 15% remained neutral, 7% disagree, and 3% strongly disagree with the statement that respondents are free to share their thoughts, ideas, and proposals42% of respondents highly agree, 35% agree, 8% remained neutral, 9% disagree, and 6% strongly disagree with the statement that colleges foster participatory decision-making. The college grievance procedure received outstanding ratings from 35% of respondents, 45% very high ratings, 12% decent ratings, 3% mediocre ratings, and 5% terrible ratings.






















## **Student Feedback Analysis**

The respondents indicated that 31% thought that at least 85% of the syllabus had been finished, 25% thought up to 84% had, and others thought very little had.46% of respondents said they thought internal evaluation was always fair. 40% of respondents thought it was mostly fair, whereas other respondents felt it was unjust.

21% of respondents say they received meaningful help and counseling from their professors, 32% believe they were treated quite well, 22% believe they received moderate support, and others believe they received ordinary care.25% of respondents feel that professors advise students about the course's scope and potential; 29% believe that this is the case most of the time; 20% believe that this occurs occasionally; and the remaining respondents believe that this occurs only very infrequently. According to the respondents, 26% think that professors use concrete examples and applications to explain abstract ideas, 40% feel that this is the case most of the time, 20% believe it happens occasionally, and others believe it happens very infrequently. According to the respondents, 17% of instructors feel they completely recognize their strengths and deficiencies and take the appropriate corrective action, 22% believe teachers can typically identify, 20% believe teachers can partially identify, and others believe teachers can very seldom identify.

Only 7% of respondents thought parent-teacher conferences were held regularly by the institution, 9% thought they were held frequently, 25% said they were only held occasionally, and others thought they were held infrequently. Very favorable reviews for the university library. 21% of respondents assessed their library experience as great, 39% as good, 16% as adequate, 19% feel the library needs development, and other respondents ranked their library experience as poor. The computer lab received average reviews. 12% of respondents said the lab was fantastic, 23% said it was good, 21% said it was sufficient, 25% think the lab needs work, and other respondents said the lab was a horrible experience. Ratings for the college canteen were average. 12% of respondents said the canteen was wonderful, 28% said it was good, 15% said it was sufficient, 27% said it could need better, and others said it was terrible. The college provides separate common areas for males and girls with indoor sports and gymnasium facilities, according to 15% of respondents who responded; 37% agree; 16% slightly agree; 10% somewhat disagree; and the remaining respondents strongly disagree. Toilet satisfaction was scored as follows: 21% for outstanding, 33% for good, 24% for adequate, and the rest for needing improvement. The degree of satisfaction with the security on college grounds was assessed as follows: 16% for outstanding, 32% for good, 27% for adequate, and the rest for needing improvement. Satisfaction with the in-house medical attention and treatment facilities was assessed as outstanding by 11%, acceptable by 32%, satisfactory by 24%, and inadequate by the remaining respondents.41% of respondents strongly believe that the college is a ragging and sexual harassment-free zone with a designated section for lodging complaints, 37% agree, 7% agree moderately, and the remainder disagree.26% of the responders strongly agrees that the college provides financial support in terms of various scholarships, 39% agrees, 15% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.16% of the responders strongly agrees that the college has several joboriented certificate courses which are offers free of cost to students, 30% agrees, 17% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.16% of the responders strongly agrees that the college has a functional career counselling and placement cell, 41% agrees, 18% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.10% of the responders strongly agrees that the college has a dedicated psychological counselling cell for students, 28% agrees, 15% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.17% of the responders strongly agrees that the college organises student-oriented seminars, workshops, debates and quizzes time to time to improve confidence and personality of students, 38% agrees, 18% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.14% of the responders strongly agrees that the college teaches moral ethics to its students and organizes student oriented motivational programmes time to time, 36% agrees, 16% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement. 17% of the responders strongly agrees that the college organizes annual athletics meet and


other cultural activities for students, 41% agrees, 18% somewhat agrees and the others disagree with this statement.
